

Fundamentally change the way humanity lives and creates its environment.




Goal

Executive Message

The Focus of 2019:

- To complete a pilot to show how GIS and GeoDesign and related technologies can be used to accelerate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda through integrated, comprehensive and holistic planning for development.
- To assist Bluefield's Bay in completing their development plan for the community to the best we can.

Accomplishments

1. Etta was invited and delivered a keynote presentation to the Regional Center for Mapping Resources for Development (RCMRD) in Nairobi, Kenya in August 12-15 to show the power of GeoDesign in achieving the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
2. We continue to be proud of our accomplishment of having completed a proof of concept and now a pilot, and in the developing world. In that regard, ICGC together with Antioch University completed a pilot in the informal settlement of Manyatta in the Port City of Kisumu, Kenya.

Emphasis for Coming Year 2020

1. A goal for 2020 is to do a side event at the United Nations sponsored by the Missions of Jamaica and Kenya to show how the pilot was conducted and to recommend that it is adopted by the UN for use as a model to accelerate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda.
2. To stress to the Member States and the Deputy Secretary General's Office that significant progress toward the implementation of the 2030 Agenda can be made by adapting the middle step of suggesting to each country, especially the LDCs and Developing Countries that integrated comprehensive planning of each country can be a significant milestone toward 2030. This could be done through the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).
3. Communicate to UN and Member States that in the next 5-6 years all developing countries can potentially complete an integrated comprehensive plan virtually in the cloud of each country.
